

Lesson Titles, Bible Verses, Bible Stories and Objectives for Spring UIM SS Series 54

“Rebuilding Patience and Endurance”

Based on: **Colossians 1:11:** *May you be strengthened with all power, according to His glorious might, for all endurance and patience with joy* and **Romans 5:3-5** - *Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us.*

February 28- **Lesson One:** Second Sunday in Lent - Series B

Who Do You Say Jesus Is?

Based on: Genesis 17:1-7, 15-16; Romans 5:1-11; and Mark 8:27-38

Bible Story: Peter's Confession - Matthew 16:13-20.

Bible Verse: But God shows His love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8.

Objective: Help generations confess Jesus to lead others to Him for faith that produces patience and endurance and salvation..

March 7- **Lesson Two:** Third Sunday in Lent - Series B

Discover God's Complete Forgiveness

Exodus 20:1-17; 1 Corinthians 1:18-3; and John 2:13-22 (23-25)

Bible Story: Jesus Clears the Temple - Mark 11:15-17.

Bible Verse: For the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men. 1 Corinthians 1:25

Objective: Uncover the deep cleansing that rebuilds patience and endurance.

March 14- **Lesson Three:** Fourth Sunday in Lent - Series B

We Are God's Workmanship

Based on: Numbers 21:4-9; Ephesians 2:1-10; and John 3:14-21

Bible Story: The Widows Mite - Luke 21:1-4. **Bible Verse:** For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them. Ephesians 2:10.

Objective: Share the workmanship rebuilds patience and endurance in present and future generations.

March 21 - **Lesson Four:** Fifth Sunday in Lent - Series B

Serving and Saving the Lost

Based on: Jeremiah 31:31-34; Hebrews 5:1-10; and Mark 10:(32-34) 35-45

Bible Story: Zacchaeus - Luke 19:1-10 **Bible Verse:** For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many. Mark 10:45. **Objective:** Share the kind of serving that saves the lost and finds patience and endurance.

March 28- **Lesson Five:** Palm Sunday- Series B

Live in Humble Obedience To God's Will

Based on: Zechariah 9:9-12; Philippians 2:5-11; and Mark 14:1-15:47 or Mark 15:1-47

Bible Story: The Passion of Christ - Luke 22:39-46. **Bible Verse:** And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Philippians 2:8. **Objective:** Share the humble obedience that rebuilds patience and endurance and saves.

April 4- **Lesson Six:** The Resurrection of our Lord - Easter Day - Series B

Rejoice and Be Glad

Based on: Isaiah 25:6-9; 1 Corinthians 15:1-11; and Mark 16:1-8

Bible Story: The Resurrection of Jesus - Matthew 28:1-10. **Bible Verse:** It will be said on that day, "Behold, this is our God; we have waited for him, that he might save us. This is the Lord; we have waited for him; let us be glad and rejoice in his salvation." Isaiah 25:9. **Objective:** Share the kind of rejoicing that helps rebuild patience and endurance in us, others, and the world.

April 11 - **Lesson Seven:** Second Sunday of Easter - Series B

Following Our Defender

Based on: Acts 4:32-35; 1 John 1:1-2:2; and John 20:19-31

Bible Story: Jesus Reinstates Peter - John 21:15-19. **Bible Verse:** My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. 1 John 2:1b.

Objective: Share how to follow Jesus as our defender and for His strength to be patient and enduring like Him.

April 18 - **Lesson Eight:** Third Sunday of Easter - Series B

Paul's Mission and Ours

Based on: Acts 3:11-21; 1 John 3:1-7; and Luke 24:36-49

Bible Story: Paul's First Missionary Journey - Selected Verses from Acts 13-14. **Bible Verse:** No one who abides in [Christ] keeps on sinning; no one who keeps on sinning has either seen Him or known Him. 1 John 3:6

Objective: Share how Paul's Christian mission and ours rebuild patience and endurance and salvation in the world

April 25 - **Lesson Nine:** Fourth Sunday of Easter - Series B

When Jesus Lives In Us

Based on: Acts 4:1-12; 1 John 3:16-24; and John 10:11-18

Bible Story: Paul and Timothy - Acts 16:1-5. **Bible Verse:** Whoever keeps his commandments abides in God, [a] and God [b] in him. And by this we know that he abides in us, by the Spirit whom he has given us. 1 John 3:24.

Objective: Share how Jesus comes to live in us and how people seeing Him in us helps to rebuild patience and endurance and saves.

May 2 - **Lesson Ten:** Fifth Sunday of Easter - Series B

Recognize the True God

Based On: Acts 8:26-40; 1 John 4:1-11(12-21); and John 15:1-8

Bible Story: Lydia - Acts 16.13-15. **Bible Verse:** By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, 1 John 4:2.

Objective: Help generations recognize and open their hearts to the only God who can rebuild patience and endurance and salvation.

May 9 - **Lesson Eleven** Sixth Sunday of Easter - Series B

Friends of Christ

Based on: Acts 10:34-48; 1 John 5:1-8; and John 15:9-17 **Bible Story:** Paul and Silas in Prison - Acts 16:16-40. **Bible Verse:** No longer do I call you servants, for the servant does not know what his master is doing; but I have called you friends, for all that I have heard from my Father I have made known to you. John 15:15.

Objective: Help generations explore friendship with Jesus and how His friendship rebuilds patience and endurance in and through us.

May 16 - **Lesson Twelve:** Seventh Sunday of Easter - Series B

God's Full and Complete Protection

Based on: Acts 1:12-26; 1 John 5:9-15; and John 17:11b-19

Bible Story: Paul Sails for Rome - Acts 27:1-44. **Bible Verse:**Holy Father, keep them in Your name, which You have given Me, that they may be one, even as We are One.. John 17:11b

Objective: Share the power that protects fully and completely to rebuild patience and endurance in us and the world

May 23- **Lesson Thirteen:** The Day of Pentecost - Series B

Sharing The New Jerusalem

Based on: Ezekiel 37:1-14; Acts 2:1-21; and John 15:26-27, 16:4b-15

Bible Story: John's Vision of Heaven - Revelation 21 and 22. **Bible Verse:** When the Spirit of truth comes, He will guide you into all the truth,.. John 16:13a.

Objective: Help generations understand the heavenly and eternal significance of having Christ's patience and endurance on earth.
